

Protect the land transformed by a moment of sacrifice

The 93-foot Tower of Voices' 40 wind chimes are now ringing throughout the Flight 93 National Memorial in Shanksville to honor the heroes who gave their lives on 9/11 to thwart a terrorist attack on the U.S. Capitol.

A quiet corner of Pennsylvania was transformed forever and the preservation of this now sacred site was made possible thanks to the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) — which will expire on September 30th if Congress does not act.

Since 1964, LWCF has helped preserve land across the Commonwealth, at no cost to taxpayers, where Americans can honor our heroes — places like Shanksville, Valley Forge, and Gettysburg.

Over \$25 million have been invested to preserve Pennsylvania's historic battlefields and sacred places including \$10 million for the Flight 93 Memorial.
